Proverbs 22:1-9

he one thing which

seems to always come up in people's conversations is the desire to increase the good in their lives. This desire is often manifested in the form of complaining about the bad in the speaker's lives. There are certainly many circumstances about which people find a need to complain. tervention. That is the mistake! The urgent usually only becomes urgent after important things have been ignored or put off in our lives. May I suggest regular fellowship with God, his word, and seasoned mentoring Believers is very important as it demonstrates humility by allowing guidance in the important things before negative things become urgent.

You Will Have Increase

Our scripture shows us there is both blessing and cursing which results from our behaviors. Each of us will have increase and the harvest of our increase. The seeds we have planted will bring either good or evil into our lives. Our scripture tells we would reap what we sow. [v. 8] We choose our increase by our words and behaviors for good or ill.

Assurance Of Increase

A generous man will be blessed, we are told in our scripture. Jesus told us we were better than the birds of the field and our Heavenly Father meets their needs. [f] Believers live in The Kingdom of The Blessing. Blessing means empowered to prosper. Take God at his word, humble yourself to his care, and be empowered to prosper!
