### "You Are The Light"

Jesus encouraged the people with some interesting words in Matthew 5: <sup>14</sup>"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. # "An Apostle's Prayer" (Teaching Sketch)

he Apostle Paul had just told the Ephesians that believers are Christ's workmanshipproduct. Having gone through the admonishments for unity in the body Paul then says an interesting thing which serves to emphasize his words. Paul says, "For this reason I kneel before the Father." Why does this emphasize his words, because it was the custom in those days to stand to pray, but Paul is demonstrating the humility necessary to function

within a body of believers.

Paul is showing leadership!

Paul prays for the Ephesians that they may receive what is necessary, from God's riches, to carry out the reason for all believers remaining in this life after salvation, gifts for service. All good gifts come from God!

#### Strength

Paul, being an apostle, had an understanding and knowledge



to share, which came as a gift to him which he passes on to the Ephesians. He emphasizes that strength comes through the Holy Spirit being in the hearts of believers. It is interesting to note that he mentions

Notes: [a] strength from God's riches first. Spiritual strength is necessary for spiritual growth, otherwise a person keeps sliding back into unbelief and confusion, living a life of defeat in spiritual matters, as well as temporal matters.

#### Power

How is it that this spiritual strength is brought about by the Spirit? Paul said, "With power through his Spirit in your inner being." He makes it clear that this comes about through Christ dwelling in the heart, through faith.

#### The Spirit in You

It is Christ's Spirit in the believer that will root and establish through love. It is this establishment in the believer


