"Walk Through Your Land"

We see in <u>Genesis 12:1-8</u> (NIV) that God promised Abram (later called Abraham) a specific area of land. Hundreds of years later Abraham's descendants followed Joshua across the Jordan to take the land that was promised to their forefather so many years before.

The Lord told Joshua:

³ I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. ⁴ Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Great Sea on the west. ^{Joshua} 1:3-4(NIV) (emphasis added)

Notice as you read on through the book of Joshua that the Israelites did not just waltz into Canaan and say, "Here we are," nor did the current habitants say, "Please take our cities and homes," and pick up and leave without an objection.

Joshua led the soldiers into the Promised Land as they fought their way through and conquered that land that God promised them. Yes, God was with them and he gave them the victory, but they had to enter the land, and enter the fight.

Let us apply this to our own lives. Each Believer has promises God has given them. Some of these promises are directly in the Word of God, and others God spoke to our hearts and confirmed through the Word. We must continually thank God for the specific promise he has given us, confess the Word that applies to that promise, and resist the enemy by refusing to fear or doubt concerning the promise God has given us. Doing these things we spiritually "walk through the land" God has given us. Physically possessing the land is not far behind. !
